We are pleased to inform you that we will be offering <u>after school clubs and activities</u> starting <u>September 11,</u> <u>2017 (Mon)</u>. Please find the details below.

DUYAN After School Clubs and Activities

Objectives:

- 1. To broaden the students' opportunities to learn by providing lessons and activities that are not offered, fully or partially, in the regular curriculum
- 2. To provide the students with venues wherein they can practice what they learn in the classroom
- 3. To foster community spirit
- 4. To provide additional and structured physical, mental, and social activities for the children

Guidelines:

- Joining an after school club or activity is **optional**. A student may join a **maximum of 3** clubs.
- Some clubs are also considered as <u>Elective Classes for JHS</u> students and therefore JHS students who enlisted in two (2) of those Elective Classes need not pay the club fee anymore. However, they have to pay for the 3rd enlistment. (Pls. see JHS Elective letter)
- The club fee should be **paid in full** upon enrollment before a child can join a club.
- The costs listed here are **not covered** by any of the fees paid at the start of the school year.
- Club fees may or <u>may not be inclusive</u> of the materials required by the club (Ex. badminton racket, guitar, clear book, violin, science materials, cooking ingredients), therefore, additional materials or payments might be required.
- The minimum number of students required by a club should be met; otherwise the club will be dissolved.
- A student enrolled in a club should <u>attend regularly</u>. No make-up session/s will be provided to any student who has been late or absent except for valid reasons upon approval by the administration.
- A student may **not** withdraw from a club once payment has been made except for valid reasons upon approval by the administration.
- Most clubs have a culminating activity i.e. recital, exhibit, competition, etc.
- A student may <u>not</u> be allowed to join a performance, exhibit, or competition related to a club if the teacher finds that his/her level of skill does not meet the standards yet.
- <u>**To bus riders**</u>, please consider your bus schedules when choosing clubs as they have already been set. Changes in bus schedules may not be accommodated.
